

January Guide to Reading through the New Testament in One Year

“All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.”

2 Tim 3:16-17

Before reading, pray that the Lord may illuminate His Word to you. Ask the Lord to grant you

- 1) Teaching – what the Bible says about any particular subject
- 2) Rebuking – exposes any areas in our thinking or behavior that do not align with what the Bible teaches
- 3) Correcting – seeing what is wrong, repenting of what is wrong, and adjusting our lives in obedience
- 4) Training in righteousness – as we get to know God through His Word, we learn how we should live our lives; to live obediently as God says in His Word is to live righteously
